Clarendon Scholarship / Brasenose Hector Pilling Scholarship

Thank you for your application for support from the Clarendon Fund. I am pleased to tell you that it has now been agreed to offer you a linked award that will cover your University and college fees and provide a grant for living expenses of £12,600 to assist you to study for the Doctor of Philosophy in History at Oxford University, beginning in October 2007.

I understand that you have agreed to move from St Anthony's College to Brasenose College because you have been awarded the Brasenose College Hector Pilling Scholarship. Congratulations! The Hector Pilling Scholarship contributes £5,000 towards your living expenses at Oxford and is awarded in conjunction with the Clarendon Scholarship. For this reason, the Clarendon Fund has agreed to top up this amount to a total of £12,600 by providing an additional £7,600 per annum so that your grant for living expenses is the equivalent of the full Clarendon Fund grant.

This letter replaces the offer letter originally sent to you on 26 March 2007, where you were offered a Clarendon Scholarship to pay for your University and college fees only.

Although you have already been informed about the revised award, I would be grateful if you could contact myself and Karen Brill to confirm that you have received this new offer letter and are happy to accept the linked award on these conditions.

The International Office will deal with the administration of the award throughout the rest of your time at Oxford (payment of fees, payment of living expenses, renewal of awards etc).

Award conditions

(i) The funds available under the scheme are limited and the university wishes to assist as many well-qualified candidates as possible. It is therefore a condition of the award that you should continue to pursue other funding applications. If you are successful in these applications, the Clarendon scholarship will be reduced in value in relation to any partial awards you obtain or withdrawn if you obtain a comparable fully funded award.

(ii) The award is provided for you to follow the Doctor of Philosophy in History. It may only be transferred to a different programme of study with the approval of the divisional Clarendon selection panel. If you do not make satisfactory progress and, as a result, you are required to repeat any periods of study the continuation of your award will be reviewed by the scholarship panel.

Duration of award

This award is for three years only.

Please let Karen Brill know as soon as possible whether you wish to accept this award on the conditions outlined above. If you do accept the award, please notify Karen as soon as possible of any funding you receive from other sources so that the panel can assist other students who require support. You must also notify Karen as soon as possible, if for any reason you decide not to come to Oxford so that the Clarendon fund can assist another suitable candidate.

May I take this opportunity to wish you every success in your future studies.
